



Individual Eligibility Criteria

These conditions are required to be eligible for your application to be processed.

CCHP requires practitioners to meet three criteria in order for the initial credentialing application to be processed:

- An active and unrestricted license without limitations or sanctions from the state(s) in which they currently practice
- Cannot be excluded from participating in Medicare or Medicaid programs (lack of sanctions or debarment) where such participation is required
- No prior denial of a completed application for credentialing with CCHP within the preceding 24 months
- No prior terminations of credentials or network participation by CCHP or any delegated credentialing organization within the preceding 24 months. Exceptions to this include:
 - Terminated because left employment with a network organization
 - Terminated because employer/practice group left CCHP network
 - Terminated because failed to submit a completed recredentialing application by deadline (see "Additional Processes for Recredentialing" section D)

Applicant must submit validated documentation that their termination from a delegated credentialing organization meets above exclusion criteria.

If the applicant fails to meet these criteria, CCHP will not process the application further. The applicant may reapply when they meet all of the criteria.
