

Codes Requiring Prior Authorization for BadgerCarePlus

The following CPT and HCPCS codes are covered by ForwardHealth but require prior authorization from Chorus Community Health Plans (CCHP) before services are rendered. CPT codes are listed first, followed by HCPCS codes. **All inpatient admissions**, including those associated with inpatient-only CPT codes, require authorization to be submitted within three (3) business days of admission.
