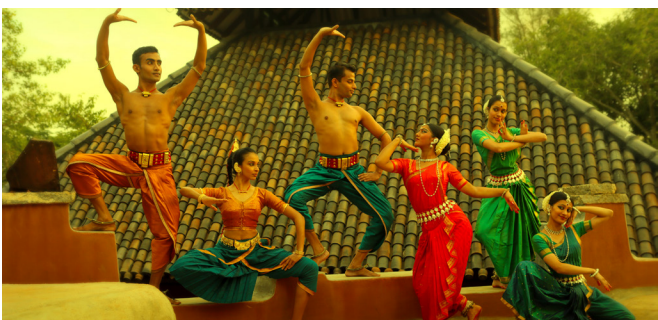




Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra February 2, 2023 at 7:30pm

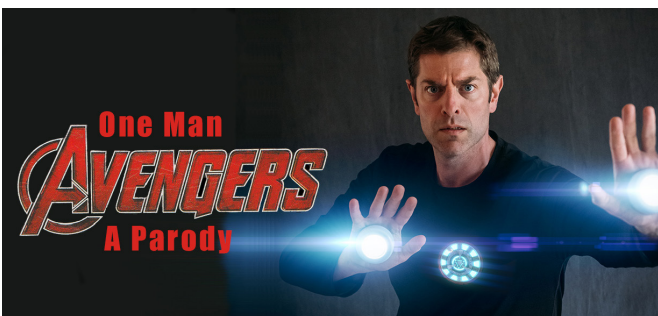
